

WIRING

The C5 Corvette PCM is in the passenger side wheel well and can be accessed by removing (6) 7mm screws from the plastic panel in the wheel well and (2) 7mm screws from the underside of the plastic panel in the wheel well. The PCM has two large 80-pin connectors. Power, RPM, vehicle speed, and TPS signals can be accessed at these connectors.


RED PCM CONNECTOR



The Cortex EBC wiring harness should be connected to the **red** PCM connector as outlined in the following table.

BLUE PCM CONNECTOR



The Cortex EBC wiring harness should be connected to the **blue** PCM connector as outlined in the following table.

RPM DETECTION:
